- 3. Overgrown shrubs or trees damaging the roof or fences.
- 4. Flowers. Shrubs, vegetables planted in the common area.
- 5. Unused satellite dishes and cables on the exterior of the building.
- 6. Garbage cans stored on the street or common area.

Unauthorized commercial use of the tennis courts and pool is not <u>allowed.</u>

Organized tennis and swimming lessons are not allowed at the Strawberry Square pool or tennis courts.

Community Member Concerns

Here are some concerns for safety here at Strawberry Square expressed by residents.

- 1. Children playing on the Association's streets such as drawing with chalk on the streets, riding bicycles, using small motorized vehicles, The common concern is that drivers of cars and delivery vehicles may not see the children at play resulting in not having enough time to avoid hitting them.
- 2. People walking on the streets and not using the sidewalks.
- 3. People driving at unsafe speeds.
- 4. Unsupervised children using playgrounds.
- 5. Unsupervised children climbing trees and breaking the branches of of them.
