




CROW SEASON – February to July

It's nesting and fledgling season for crows! During this time, you may notice:
Fledgling crows (young birds) on the ground – they've left the nest but aren't great flyers yet.
Protective adult crows nearby – they may "dive-bomb" people to protect their young.

This is normal and not meant to harm you.

 If you see a fledgling on the ground,
please leave it alone – the parents are usually nearby, and the young bird is learning.

If crow activity is bothering you, the best thing to do is avoid the area temporarily. This season only lasts a few months, and your understanding helps local wildlife thrive!
