I know it is odd to think about water conservation after having so much rainfall recently..... But. ...California is not out of the woods as far as drought is concerned. San Jose Water District has some very useful information on their website www.sjwater.com

From Snowpack Surveys, Reservoir Levels, Where Santa Clara water comes from, Current Drought Monitors and Residential and Commercial Drought Resources.

Strawberry HOA and Strawberry Management have been monitoring water use in Strawberry Square for the past year. The Landscape Crew cut back on water use during the hot months of 2022 and were able to save Strawberry Square just over \$31,000 in water cost by doing so. We are also working with SJ Water to be able to monitor water use residentially as well as irrigation so we all can work at keeping the water use down at Strawberry to do our part for water conservation as well as keep the HOA Dues as low as possible since water is covered by the H.O.A. There will be regular water update postings on the Strawberry Website as well as the Newsletters.

DOG WASTE

As mentioned in last months Newsletter this new trend of leaving dog waste for others to pick up has overwhelmed the Grounds Crew. Dog waste is either left for others to step in or put in bags and thrown in planted areas, next to fences and on the grass. If you see any of your neighbors neglecting to complete their dog waste responsibilities please KINDLY remind them of Strawberry Squares Rule "Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up their pet's litter. {Ref. p 14, 11.3}". If the dog owner is not from Strawberry Square please KINDLY remind them to clean up after their dog and not to leave it behind for others to do so.
